Truck fuel bills can be cut $\hat{=}$ 5,700 if new technology deployed, report finds

Trucks could be up to 18 % more fuel efficient and save hauliers $\hat{=}$ 5,700 a year by using technology that is already available, a new report by sustainable transport group Transport & Environment (T&E) shows. However, market forces are not driving uptake of the technologies with, for example, turbocompounding delivering a 3 % fuel saving but only being installed in 0.24 % of European trucks $\hat{=}$ despite having being on the market for 15 years.
